

## NuRedOx COST Action – ITC Conference Grants Guidelines

### In Practice, HOW TO APPLY

Interested researchers can apply by following the directions provided below and submitting their application and supporting documents by logging into e-COST and clicking on the ITC Conference Grants tab. #### ELIGIBILITY

**1. Applicant, PhD students or Early Career Investigators (ECI's, PhD + 8 years maximum)** with a primary affiliation in an institution located in a COST Inclusiveness Target Country (ITC): *Bosnia-Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Croatia, Hungary, Lithuania, Latvia, Luxembourg, Malta, Montenegro, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Republic of Serbia and Turkey.*

**2.** The applicant must have an oral/poster presentation accepted at the conference in question and must be listed in the official event/conference programme. The main subject of the oral presentation/poster presentation/speech at the approved conference must be on the topic of ASF-STOP and must acknowledge COST.

**3.** Attendance at European conferences is preferred but conferences held elsewhere can also be considered.

#### THE APPLICATION PROCESS

**1.** Applicants have to obtain a written validation from the Conference Organiser confirming the acceptance of a submitted scientific presentation (either oral presentation or poster).

**2.** The grant application must be submitted at least 45 days before the Conference start date.

**3.** Attendance at the conference and the application process must start and end during the same Grant Period.

**4.** All applicants must register for an e-COST profile at <https://e-services.cost.eu/> - adding their bank account details and a full C.V. to their profile.

**5.** All applicants must complete and submit their ITC Conference Grant applications and upload supporting documents by logging into e-COST and following instructions after clicking on the ITC Conference Grants tab.

#### DEADLINES

**COST NutRedOx** runs an open call system for ITC Conference Grants. This means that applications can be submitted any time, but definitely 45 days prior to the planned conference attendance. Received applications will be promptly evaluated and financial support will be awarded based on available budget. **NutRedOx** Grant Periods start on the 1<sup>st</sup> of May each year.
