Presentation and objectives

In line with the 1st international symposium "tennis in the society of tomorrow" organized in Dijon from April 3rd to 5th, 2008, this 2nd event wishes above all to bring together multiple actors interested in this activity, be they academics, leaders, coaches, or industrialists.

Twelve years ago, nearly 300 participants had already gathered in Burgundy to exchange ideas and find solutions and innovations for tennis management, teaching, coaching and research. A 482-page book was produced on this occasion. The same ambition will animate actors - both old and new - to define the contours of tennis tomorrow.

The year 2020 is a major date in the history of French tennis since the Federation was founded a century ago. Thus, the 2020 symposium is part of this centenary and will see the presence of many leaders of the FFT, leagues, departmental committees and clubs.

The exchanges will not be reduced to tennis, but will also concern, in a prospective aim, the impact of tennis on the society of tomorrow.

The objectives of the conference are :

- Propose an inventory of knowledge to draw up the current situation of tennis and analyze future developments.
- Confront the knowledge generated by research with the experiences of tennis coaching, education, and management professionals.
- Identify the challenges that tennis players will face in order to ensure its development in the future.

The themes will be approached from the historical and / or contemporary and / or prospective angle in each pole :

- HISTORY, MEMORY & HERITAGE
- EQUIPMENT & INNOVATIONS
- CONSUMPTION, MANAGEMENT & DEVELOPMENT
- TENNIS & HEALTH
- PEDAGOGY, LEARNING & TRAINING



Congress audience

Nearly 400 delegates, national and international, are expected for this high level event (scientific and professional) to exchange and produce knowledge in the field of tennis, in all its components.

Congress venue: UFR STAPS DIJON

The Faculty of Sport Sciences Dijon-Le Creusot is located 15 minutes from downtown Dijon, near many places of accommodation. It is very well served by public transport and easy access from the train station (Tram Line 1, university stop).

The space dedicated to the congress will be organized as follows :

- Multiplex room dedicated to exhibitors, partners, poster sessions and breaks
- 2 amphitheatres (> 300 and 150 seats) and 4 halls (70 to 100 seats) for conferences and communication sessions
